CONTESTANTS

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES AS A REGISTERED CONTESTANT

Ensure your registration is current. This includes
Registration, Serology and Certificate of Fitness.
Take your Contestant Record Book to every contest,
medical examination and weigh-in.
Give your Contestant Record Book to Commission
staff before the pre-contest medical examination, at
the weigh-in.
Collect your Record Book from the Medical
Practitioner after completing the post-contest medical
examination.
Have a pre-contest and a post-contest medical
examination with the Medical Practitioner at all
contests.
If you last competed outside of Western Australia,
you must provide the Medical Practitioner with details
of your last contest at the pre-contest medical



CONTESTANT HEALTH

It is not recommended that you:
☐ Use diuretic tablets and saunas within seven (7) days of

a contest.Take or allow any person to administer any substance or method that is listed in the World Anti-Doping Code

by the World Anti-Doping Agency as a prohibited

substance or method.

You MUST:

Immediately comply with	any	direction	to partic	cipate ir
testing for prohibited subs	stan	ces.		

- Report the use of a medication prescribed by a Medical Practitioner to the examining Medical Practitioner at the pre-contest medical examination.
- Report the use of medication prescribed by a Medical Practitioner, to the Commission a minimum of five (5) days prior to the contest. The information is to be placed on a Therapeutic Use Exemption form by your Medical Practitioner.

WA CONTESTANTS COMPETING ELSEWHERE

A WA Commission registered Contestant competing interstate or overseas must advise the Commission of the following details within seven (7) days after the contest:

- The name of your opponent.
- The number of rounds scheduled.
- The contest result including the number of rounds contested.
